Churchill, pretrial services officer, presenting an official report upon the conduct of defendant Moshe Elmakias, who was placed under pretrial release supervision by the Honorable Lurana S. Snow sitting in the Court at Ft. Lauderdale, on April 24, 2003, under the following conditions:

1. Report to Pretrial Services as directed;
2. Electronic Monitoring;
